

SSC, Dhakil exams begin

The Secondary School Certificate Examinations under five Education Boards and Dakhil Examination under Madrasa Education Board began all over the country Sunday.

A total of 4,78,275 SSC examinees and about 75,000 Dakhil examinees were scheduled to appear in SSC examinations and Dakhil examinations respectively.

On the first day of SSC examination about 500 candidates were expelled for adopting unfair means in examination centres in different

centres under Dhaka, Rajshahi and Jessore education boards. The actual number of expelled examinees would be more since a large number of examination centres could not give details to their respective education board authorities on Sunday.

Of the available number of expelled candidates, 133 were from Dhaka, 327 from Rajshahi and 27 from Jessore. According to Dhaka Board control room, the number of examinees expelled in districts were as follows: Gazipur-3, Narsingdi-1, Munshiganj-2, Manikganj-10, Mymensingh-16, Jamalpur-13, Netrokona-44, Sherpur-2, Faridpur-2, Gopalganj-1, Rajbari-1 and Madaripur-1.

In the capital city the first day of the SSC examination passed off peacefully. The Dhaka Metropolitan Police earlier imposed ban on gathering and movement of more than four people within 200 yards of SSC and Dhakil examination centres for smooth holding of these examinations.

Our Rajshahi Correspondent adds: A total of 327 candidates was expelled on Sunday the first day of S.S.C examinations in nine districts under Rajshahi Education Board.

The district wise break up is 4 were expelled in Rajshahi, 193 in Dinajpur, 47 in Bogura, 34 in Gaibandha, 19 in Nilphamari, 17 in Naogaon, 6 in Pabna, 4 in Panchagarh, 3 in

Natore district.

BSS from Chittagong says: At least 74 SSC examinees were expelled Sunday from 31 centers in the Chittagong city and outlying areas for adoption of unfair means, according to official source in Chittagong.

The number of expelled examinees might be higher when reports from all the 68 centres were received, the source added.

the Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Chittagong. Over 46,000 examinees are appearing in the examination. There are 21 examination centres in the city.

The examination was held peacefully in the city's centres on Sunday, the sources said.
