

## BCL, JCD hold separate rallies at DU

Ruling party's student front Chhatra League (BCL) and BNP's student wing JCD Thursday brought out separate processions on the Dhaka University campus protesting the killing of their leaders, reports UNB.

BCL took out its procession in the morning to protest the killing of its leader Omar Faruk Rubel and rickshawpuller Abdul Awal in Feni Tuesday.

Rubel, 20, and Awal, 22, were gunned down during a clash between BCL and BNP backed Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) in the Feni town.

Later BCL held a rally at the foot of 'Aparajeyo Bangla' with BCL president Bahadur Bepari in the chair.

Addressing the rally, Bepari demanded immediate arrest of the killers and their exemplary punishment.

"Three evil forces — rajaker, autocrats, and hijackers — are hatching conspiracy to oust the government and these killings are the parts of their blueprint," Bepari told the rally.

Party leaders Ajay Kar khokan, Sujit Roy Nandi, Ashraful Azam Ruban, Sajjad Hossain and AKM Azim also addressed the rally.

JCD also brought out its procession in the morning and held a rally in front of DUCSU Bhaban protesting the killing of Kabul Hossain Kabul in Manikganj Tuesday.

Kabul, 23, an MA student of Govt Debendro College and Manikganj district JCD leader was chopped to death allegedly by the BCL men.

Addressing the rally, JCD president Habibunnabi Sohel said the ruling party has embarked on the politics of killing and they would destroy themselves by this destructive politics.

He demanded immediate arrest and exemplary punishment to the killers, or else, he threatened, "JCD will topple the government by a mass movement."

Presided over by JCD DU unit president Manir Hossain, the rally was addressed, among others, by Farhad Hossain Azad, Sultaqn Salahuddin Tuku, Rehana Akhter Ranu, Mostafizul Islam Mamun and Asaduzzaman Asad.
