DHAKA, Dec 18 (BSS) : The government has formed a committee comprising eminent educationists to review, evaluate and correct the text books for introducing the possible corrected textbooks from the next academic year.

The committee was formed as the government observed that there are some linguistic and informative flaws in the existing textbooks of primary and secondary education levels, an official handout said today.
