Call to lift ban on note books

Bangladesh Book Publishers and Sellers Association on Monday demanded cancellation of the law banning publication of note books upto Class viii within January 24. If the law is not repealed within the deadline, the Association would keep closed all the book stalls throughout the country for three days beginning from January 25.

Mr. Abu Taher, Secretary General of the Association told this at a press conference at the Jatiya Press Club on the day.

Earlier, a rally of the members of the association was held at Bahadur Shah Park. They also brought out a procession parading different city streets. Later, a memorandum of the association was handed over to the President's personal staff at Bangabhaban.

A copy of the memorandum was handed over also to the Education Minister at his Secretariat Chamber.

All book stalls in the country were kept closed on the day.
