

Govt college teachers' strike

The teachers of BCS General Education Cadre will observe a two-day strike in all government colleges on September 1 and 2 in protest against the appointment of members of the administrative cadre in mass education project and to press for creating the post of A.D.C. (Education) in all districts with members from the education cadre.

The teachers of the government colleges will hold their general meeting at 3 p.m. at the Teachers Training College in Dhaka on September 3 to announce their next course of action to realise their 16-point demands, that include salary hike, seniority and promotion, creation of new posts and inclusion of teachers in the warrant of precedence on the basis of pay scale.

In a statement Dr. Q.A.T.M. Habibur Rahman, President and Mr. Abu Yusuf, Secretary General of BCS General Education Association said that the teachers of government colleges had been forced to go on strike due to dilly dally process of the administration in implementing their 16-point demand.
