

Jagannath College teachers' team calls on PM

A teachers delegation of Jagannath University College led by Principal Q.A.T.M. Habibur Rahman called on Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia at her Sugandha Office in Dhaka on Monday night, reports BSS.
