638 expelled on 2nd day of SSC exams

More than 638 examinees were expelled on the second day at Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examinations from different centres under five education boards for adopting unfair means in the examination, according to different Education Board Control Rooms.

The actual number of expelled examinees would be more since a large number of examination centres could not give details to their respective education board authorities on Monday.

Of the available number of expelled candidates, 132 were

expelled from Dhaka Board, 343 from Rajshahi Board, 19 from Jessore Board and 144 from Chittagong Board.

According to Dhaka Board control room, the number of examinees expelled in districts were as follows: Narasingdi-21, Munshiganj-2, Manikganj-15, Jamalpur-7, Netrakona-15, Sherpur-4, Tangail-6, Fritpur-2, Gopalganj-1, Rajbari-2, Madaripur-11, Kishoreganj-5, Shariatpur-4, Mymensingh-31 and Gazipur-6.

According to Rajshahi Board control room, expelled candidates in districts were—Dinajpur-169, Rajshahi-34, Natore-8, Naogaon-29, Pabna-4, Bogra-53, Gaibandha-27, Nilphamari-11 and Panchagarh-8.

According to Jessore Board control room, the number of examinees expelled in districts were as follows: Patuakhali-4, Jessore-8, Kushtia-1 and Magura-6.
