ADAB hails declaration of Mother Language Day

The Association of Development Agencies in Bangladesh (ADAB) on Saturday welcomed the declaration of Ekushey February as the "International Mother Language Day" saying that this decision has enhanced the dignity of Bangla language and the Bengali nation as a whole, reports BSS.
