Most of city schools exams rescheduled

Most of the city schools have rescheduled their annual examination this year due to closure of the schools during recent political programmes and related incidents.

Generally the annual examination and the test to select S.S.C. candidates are held in November.

According to reports from city schools, none could begin the annual examination till the end of the third week of this month.

A good number of city schools have changed their date for annual examination

more than once. Few of them, however, earlier decided to hold their examination in the last week of this month.

According to Holy Cross School authorities, they are not in much difficulty with regard to examination. They started the test on Wednesday and would begin the annual examination on Monday next.

In BAF Shaheen School, the test examination was deferred from November 12 to November 19, and the annual examination from November 21 to November 23. The Government Laboratory School also made
