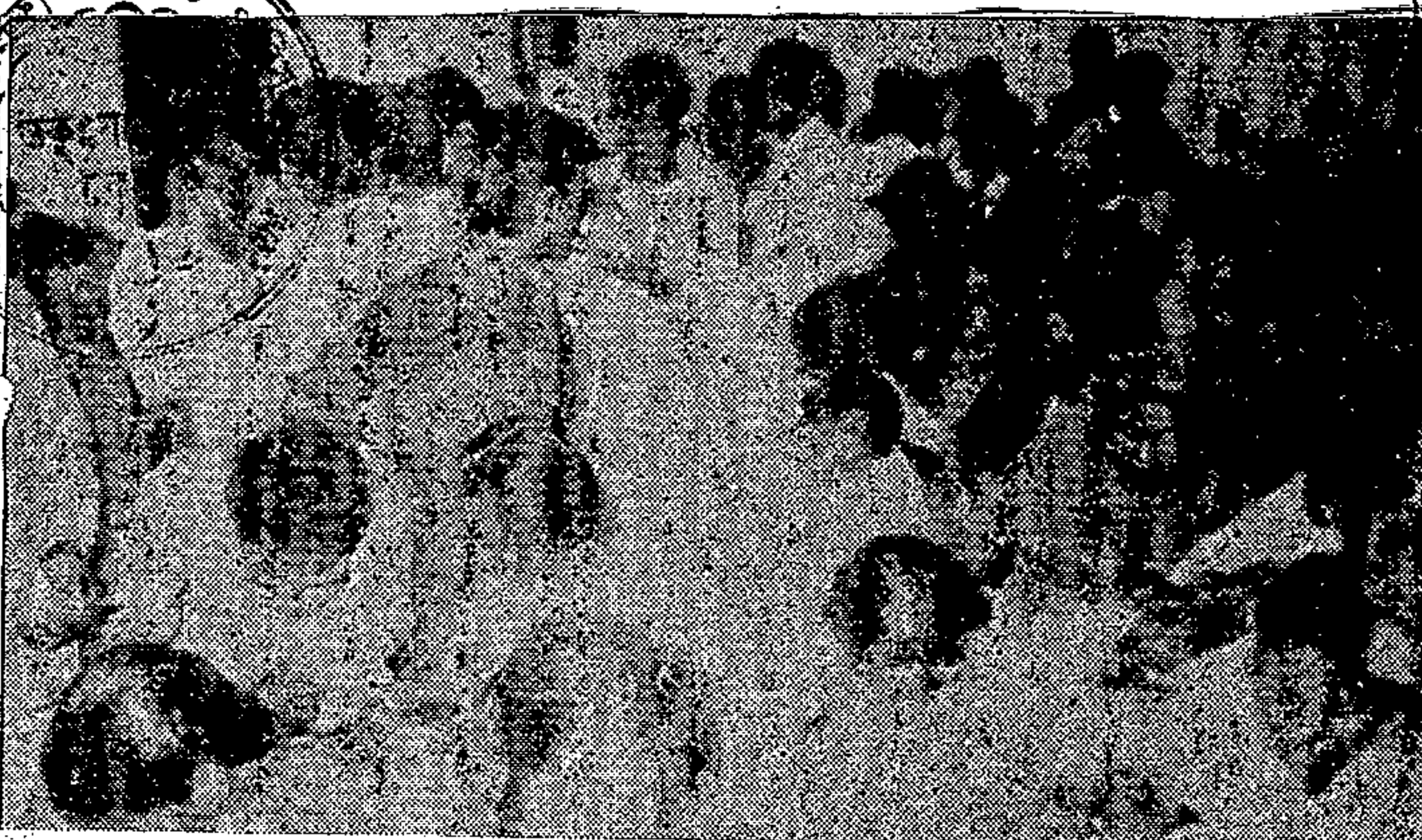

SSC examinations 8,600 expelled in three days

More than 8,600 examinees were expelled from different centres throughout the country in three days for adopting unfair means in the Secondary School Certificate Examinations.

Of them, about 2,500 students were expelled from the centres for adopting unfair means in the Mathametic examinations on Monday.

Talking to BSS the Education Minister, Sheikh Shahidul Islam said the number of expelled students surpassed last year's figure due to 'strict vigilance' in the examination centres.

Another message from Rajshahi says: a total of 3,728 examinees were expelled for adopting unfair means in three days of the SSC examinations under Rajshahi Board.

The sources said the Headmaster of Shibganj Model High School under Nawabganj district created a record when he took examination of his son's English paper on 18th night. On getting the information the Deputy Commissioner and Superintendent of Police rushed to the spot and arrested the Headmaster and another teacher for abetting the offence, the sources added.

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SSC examinations

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High School under Charchat Upazila of Rajshahi district was arrested on Monday for assisting some examinees.

Our staff reporter adds: the examination on the third day passed off peacefully baring an incident of assault on an invigilator in Gopalganj. Police arrested one person in this connection.

According to Dhaka Board sources, 650 candidates were expelled from different centres under the board.

Two invigilators at Nakla and another at Sherpur were also expelled for helping the examinees.

According to Our Gopalganj Correspondent, some unruly people assaulted the project implementation officer of Mokhsedpur upazila when he came out of the examination hall after attending the examination duty. The UNO and Upazila Chairman of Mokhsedpur also came under mob attack when they came to rescue the PIO.

In Comilla Board, four invigilators of Laksam and 268 candidates from different centres were expelled for adopting unfair means in the examination.

Our Jessore Correspondent informed that two teachers were expelled from Kaliganj centre by the Chairman of the Board. One invigilator of Noapara centre and 140 candidates from 17 out of total 100 centres were expelled on the day.
