# 413 expelled on 3rd day of HSC exams

A total of 413 examinees were expelled from different centres on the third day of HSC examinations Tuesday on charge of adopting unfair means. No untoward incident was however reported till mid night last night.

### COMILLA

Our Comilla Correspondent reports: 193 examinees were expelled from ten centres of Comilla Board Tuesday. Of them, 140 expelled from six centres of Comilla district, 50 from three centres of Chandpur district and three from a centre in Chittagong.

Police siezed nine bags of scripts from examinees at the Chauddagram upazila centre in Comilla while they were adopting unfair means. A total of 54 examinees were expelled from this centre.

Police arrested two copy suppliers at Muradnagar upazila centre.

### PABNA

Our Pabna Correspondent reports: A total of 207 HSC examinees were expelled from

nine out of 12 centres of the district yesterday.

### FARIDPUR

Our Faridpur Correspondent adds: Thirteen HSC examinees were expelled from two centres of Faridpur district. Police arrested one person for supplying copies to the examinees.

### CHITTAGONG

Report from our Chittagong Bureau says, the physics examination of HSC was disrupted when a group of outsiders attacked Aathazari College centre Tuesday afternoon. The attackers who fired several blank shots were chased away by police and the examination resumed within 20 minutes.

### MANIKGANJ

Our Manikganj Correspondent writes: Over 100 examinees did not appear at the Mohadebpur College centre of the district as the authorities had taken strict measures against unfair means.

Earlier, 92 examinees were expelled from this centre for adopting unfair means.
