Concern over delay in DU exam result

The results of the Honours final examinations of 1987 (held in 1989) Bengali and Public Administration Departments of Dhaka University have not been announced even after seven months of completion of the examinations.

About 232 students of the two departments are suffering for the unusual delay. They apply for jobs.

In the Department of Management, the situation is even worse. The results of the masters degree examinations in Management of 1986 which were held eight months ago are yet to be announced.

It is learnt that the teachers of the Department of Management are blaming one another for the delay.

93 examinees of the Department of Bengali and 83 examinees of the Department of Public Administration have met the Vice-Chancellor, the Pro-Vice-Chancellor, the Controller of examinations and Chairmen of the Departments, but without any result.

The Dean of the Faculty of Arts Dr. Wakil Ahmed told the Times that explanations had already been asked from the Department of Bengali about the cause of the delay.

He said that "the academic council has taken up the matter and meetings will be held to solve the problem soon."

Meanwhile, masters' degree classes in these Departments have already been started without the announcement of the honours final results.

Under university rules, the Department are required to announce result within three months of the completion of examinations.
