## DU offers M Phil courses on Nazrul

The first meeting of the managing committee of the newly set-up Nazrul Research Centre of University of Dhaka was held on April 17 with Prof M Moniruzzaman Miah, Vice-Chancellor of the University in the chair.

The meeting decided that the Nazrul Research Centre of the University will be formally inaugurated on Jhalothya 11, 1397

B.S. Extensive research at M Phil and Ph. D. levels on the

life, works and music of Nazrul would be possible at the centre.

Candidates with M.A. degree in Bengali and English literature will be eligible to have M. Phil course in Nazrul literature

while candidates having M. A. degree in Bengali, English, History, Philosophy or Sociology will be eligible to participate in the M. Phil course on Nazrul's life.

'A' grade artists on Nazrul music in radio and television having M A degree in any subject will also be considered for research at M. Phil level.
