37.80 p. c. pass HSC Exams

The results of the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examination of 1983 of the four education boards in the country were announced simultaneously on Saturday. The average percentage of pass in the four boards is 37.80. A total of 1,48,344 candidates appeared at the examination of the four boards. Of the total number of candidates of the four boards, 55,096 came out successful in the examination. Of the successful candidates, 5,009 secured First Division. The number of female candidates in the four boards were 27,706 out of which 10,749 passed. The highest percentage of pass was recorded at Comilla Board which is 47.61 followed by Dhaka Board 38.78, Jessore Board 32.46 and Rajshahi Board 32.36.

The first nine in the combined merit list of Dhaka Board have secured more marks than the first two boys of the Jessore Board. The ninth boy of the combined merit list of Dhaka Board secured 885 while the first two boys of the Jessore Board have secured 880.

Monalisa Habib, who stood first in Rajshahi Board, has secured equal number of marks with Mohammad Marjuz Ali of Dhaka Board who stood ninth. The second boy of the Rajshahi Board has the same marks with the two candidates who secured tenth position in Dhaka Board, 873.

Jasim Imran of Comilla Board is the lone candidate to have secured more than 900 marks among the candidates of Rajshahi, Jessore and Comilla boards. The first boy of Comilla Board has the equal number of marks with the fourth and fifth boys of the Dhaka Board, at 901.

Six candidates of Dhaka Board have secured more than 900 marks in the examination.

Among the first 20 positions of the Dhaka Board, candidates from the Dhaka College secured nine positions, candidates from Mirzapur Cadet College secured five positions while candidates from the Holy Cross College and Residential Model School and College shared eight positions each. Nalla Khan of Dhaka Board with 896 marks to her credit has secured the highest number of marks among the female candidates of all the four boards.
