HSC results : girls do better

The overall percentage of pass in the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) Examinations of 1985 under the four education boards of the country is 51.42, according to the results announced in Dhaka on Friday simultaneously.

A total of 1,80,227 candidates had appeared at the examinations from the four education boards of Dhaka, Comilla, Rajshahi and Jessore. Of them 92,670 passed the examinations—9,237 in the first division, 49,326 in second division and 34,108 in third division.

The percentage of pass varied widely among the four boards. There was the highest (59.48) percentage of pass in Comilla Board, followed by 52.19 p. c in Rajshahi Board, 48.23 per cent in Dhaka Board and 47.14 per cent in Jessore Board.

The highest number of students (54,616) had appeared un-

der Dhaka Board, followed by 45,243 from Jessore Board, 41,918 from Comilla Board and 38,391 from Rajshahi Board, the result showed.

GROUPWISE

Groupwise, the highest percentage of pass (59.48) was in the Science Group under which 39,435 candidates out of 66,301 had passed the examinations with 8,167 in first division, 24,659 in second division and 6,609 in third division.

In Humanities group out of 69,689 candidates who had appeared at the examination 31,334 came out successful—639 being placed in first division 13,523 in second division and 17,222 in third division.

The percentage of pass in Commerce Group was 49.48. In this group 19,458 candidates out of 39,321 came out successful. Of them 248 were in first division, 9,392 in second division.

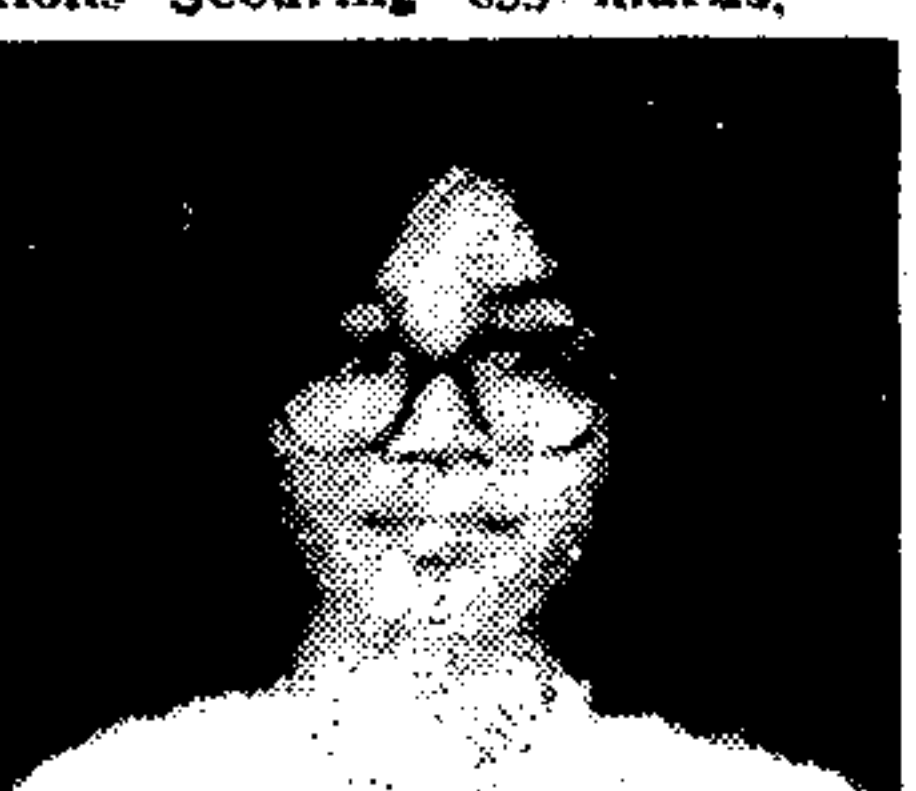

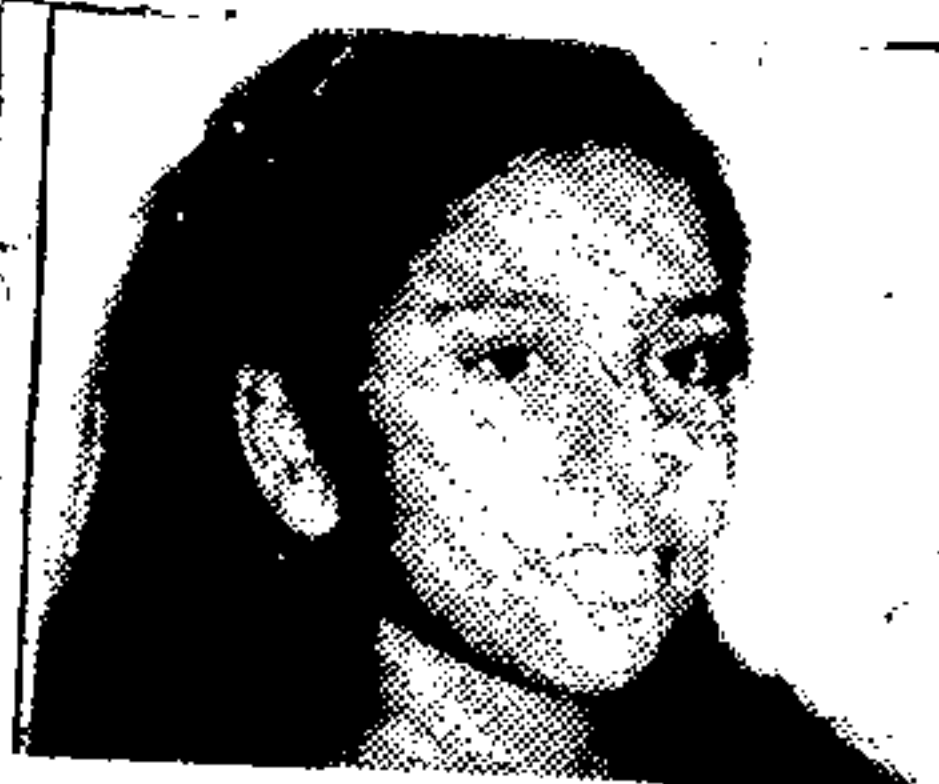

Khaleda demands representative government

CAIBANDHA, Oct 25: Begum Khaleda Zia, Chairman, BNP (Khaleda) called upon the people last evening to be united to establish a democratic government in the country.

Addressing a workers' rally at the local Public Library Hall Begum Zia said that her party believed in representative government elected through fair elections. The rally was organised by the district unit of BNP.

The BNP Chairman alleged that jute and sugarcane growers were being deprived of fair prices for their produces due to what she called "a wrong policy pursued by the present Government".

She demanded early release of students and two local popurashava commissioners who were arrested in connection with the firing incident of October 7.

Begum Zia was accompanied by central leaders of the party including Mr K M Obaidur Rahman, Barrister Najmul Huda and Mirza Abdul Halim.
