



The overall percentage of pass in the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) Examinations of 1985 under the four education boards of the country is 51.42, according to the results announced in Dhaka on Friday simultaneously.

A total of 1,80,227 candidates had appeared at the examinations from the four education boards of Dhaka, Comilla, Rajshahi and Jessore. Of them 92,670 passed the examinations — 9,237 in the first division, 49,326 in second division and 34,108 in third division.

The percentage of pass varied widely among the four boards. There was the highest (59.48) percentage of pass in Comilla Board, followed by 52.19 p. c in Rajshahi Board, 48.23 per cent in Dhaka Board and 47.14 per cent in Jessore Board.

The highest number of students (54,616) had appeared un-

der Dhaka Board, followed by 45,243 from Jessore Board, 41,918 from Comilla Board and 38,391 from Rajshahi Board, the result showed.

## GROUPWISE

Groupwise, the highest percentage of pass (59.48) was in the Science Group under which 39,435 candidates out of 66,301 had passed the examinations with 8,167 in first division, 24,659 in second division and 6,609 in third division.

In Humanities group out of 68,689 candidates who had appeared at the examination 31,324 came out successful—639 being placed in first division 13,523 in second division and 17,222 in third division.

The percentage of pass in Commerce Group was 49.48. In this group 19,458 candidates out of 39,321 came out successful. Of them 34% were in first division, 9,392 in second division

## GIRLS DO BETTER

Female candidates did better in the Higher Secondary Certificate Examinations of 1985 under all the education boards except Jessore according to the results announced on Friday. Overall the percentage of pass

of female candidates in the four boards stood at 52.04, while that of male candidates stood at 51.25.

Out of a total of 32,098 female candidates appearing under the four boards, 19,828 passed the examinations with 1,865 in First Division, 10,478 in Second Division and 7,485 in Third Division.

In Dhaka Board the percentage of pass of female candidates was 50.72 compared to 47.50 per cent pass among male candidates. Similarly the 59.13 per cent pass among male candi-
