## MBBS Examination

Sir,

The issue of holding the final professional MBBS examination as per schedule seems to face an uncertain future. This uncertainty, it is reasonably feared, if comes true, will make the problem of session jam all the more complicated. As a result of this medical session jam it has not been possible for the first year medical students of '88-89 academic session to start their class yet.

It will not be irrelevant to mention here that the final professional MBBS Exam of four medical colleges under Dhaka University is scheduled to be held on May 16 next. The first year class of these examinees started in April 1983. As per rule the final examination was scheduled to be held in May '88. Unfortunately, enough the date of the mentioned examination has so far been shifted [as many as three times].

It is learnt that the majority of the intending candidates are very much in favour of the examination to be held on May 16, though a small group of them is reported to be trying to put pressure on the authority to shift the date of the examination. We would however request the authority concerned not to yield to any pressure but to strictly adhere to the principle of holding the exam on
