## Adoption of unfair means rampant Police, mob clash in exam centres

The fourth day of SSC Examinations passed off peacefully in Dhaka city except clashes reported from different districts on Monday. Adoption of unfair means at the SSC Examinations on a mass scale outside Dhaka was a major cause of trouble at the examination centres this year.

At least five persons were injured in Noapara at Jessore when police opened fire at Jhikargacha SSC Centre to disperse a group of copy suppliers.

In Barisal district policemen resorted to fire blank shots & lathi charge at Gournali to disperse an organised gang of copy suppliers.

In Kishorganj, six persons including Tarail Upazila Engineer and two police personnel were injured in clashes with the mob following the expulsion of an examinee from the centre.

In Rangpur police opened fire to disperse an unruly mob

at Gobindaganj SSC centre following a clash. Our Noapara correspondent reports Out of five injured copy suppliers three were admitted to hospital in a critical condition.

According to police the copy suppliers turned violent when the guards at the Zikargacha Centre asked them to leave the place. The angry copy suppliers snatched away a rifle from a police man on duty there.

Our Barisal correspondent reports that four police men including the OC Kotwali Thana were injured in the clash that took place between the police guards and copy suppliers at Gournali Centre.

Our Rangpur correspondent said that the police resorted to open fire as a mob tried to violate Section 144 at Gobindaganj Centre and attacked a

police guard. Five persons were taken into custody in this connection.

It is reported that the examinees got angry at the expulsion of one examinee. At one stage brick batteing the officials at the centre.

The police had to open seven rounds of fire bring the situation under control.

The examination was started again after one hour. In all 52 examinees were expelled on Sunday in the district.
