Rajshahi Medical College reopens

RAJSHAHI, Aug. 31.—The hostels of Rajshahi Medical College (RMC) were reopened today under strict security measures and classes will resume on Saturday after a five-day unscheduled closure, reports UNB.

The college was closed sine die and resident students were asked to vacate hostels on short notice on August 28 in view of the deteriorating campus situation.

The decision of reopening the RMC was taken at a tripartite meeting attended by the Director General of Health, student representatives and college authorities here today, RMC sources said.

The college authorities, however, postponed all examinations scheduled to be held from September 3. The revised time-tables of the exams would be announced soon, sources said.

The meeting adopted strict measures to prevent the entry of outsiders into the college campus. All students have been asked to carry their identity cards.

Police, already posted on the campus, have been empowered to take necessary measures including search to resist the outsiders.
