

1044 SSC examinees expelled on Third day

A total of 1,044 students were expelled on the third day of the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) Examinations on Monday according to reports received from four Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Boards in Dhaka on Monday night.

Control room of the Comilla Board told BSS over telephone that besides 148 students, three invigilators were expelled and three outsiders arrested.

The students were expelled for adopting unfair means, the invigilators were expelled for supplying copies to the examinees and the outsiders were arrested for supplying copies.

An official of Dhaka Board said 356 examinees were expelled while Jessore Board confirmed 34 expulsion.

Rajshahi Board office said 504 students were expelled on Monday from different centers of the Board.

The total number of expulsions rose to 8,661 in three days of examinations under the four boards.

According to available reports, 3,442 examinees were expelled from Dhaka Board, 1131 from Comilla Board, 3,915 from Rajshahi Board and 173 from Jessore Board.
