27.39 pc pass in Rajshahi Board HSC exams

Results of the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examinations, 1990, held under the Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education, Rajshahi were announced on Thursday. The percentage of pass was 27.39.

A total of 66774 students appeared in the examinations and 18,295 came out successful. Of them, 1646 were placed in the First Division, 9506 in the second Division and 7143 in the Third Division.

A total of 20135 students belonging to the science group appeared in the examinations of them 7573 came out successful. In the science group, 1355 were placed in the First Division, 4547 in the Second Division and 1671 in the Third Division. The percentage of pass for science group was 37.61.

In the humanities group, 33662 students appeared and 7635 passed. The percentage of pass was 22.68. A total of 224 students were placed in the First Division, 3209 in the Second Division and 4202 in the Third Division.

In the commerce group, out of 12,977 students appeared in the examinations, 3087 got passed. The percentage of pass was 23.78. Of the successful candidates, 67 were placed in the First Division,

1750 in the Second Division and 1270 in the Third Division.

Of the total students appeared, 51,347 were males and 15427 were females. The success rate for male students was 27.56 per cent and for female students 26.84 per cent.
