

Degree examinees demand copying facilities

BOGRA, May 13:—A total of 115 degree candidates of Nazir Akhtar Government College centre in Sonatal upazila of the district abandoned their examinations protesting expulsion and demanding copying facilities, witnesses said here today, reports UNB.

The candidates walked out of the examination hall after the Magistrate Shamsul Islam expelled four examinees for adopting unfair means today on the second day of the degree examination under Rajshahi University.

The College authorities tried to persuade the examinees to return to the examination hall but failed as the students demanded withdrawal of the expulsion orders against the four examinees, sources told UNB.

They also demanded free copying rights in the examination, sources said.

Altogether 112 degree examinees were expelled from five centres of the district during English and Chemistry first paper examinations held today.

Meanwhile, 27 degree examinees were expelled from two centres in the district of Chapai Nawabganj today.
