DU Degree Pass exams in retrospect

Times Report

The colleges of Dhaka city fared better this year in the B.A. (Pass), B.Com. (Pass) and B.Sc. (Pass) examinations held under the University of Dhaka.

Three students of the Lalmata Mahila College secured First Division in the B.A. (Pass) examination while 79.3 per cent of students from the Siddhewari Girls' College passed.

Fifty-four per cent of the candidates present of the Dhaka City College passed the B.Com. (Pass) examination, while Baliakandi College and Sreebordi College had cent per cent pass. Of course, it must be remembered that only three students

of Baliakandi College and two students of the Sreebordi College sat for the B.Com. (Pass) examination.

Four students of the Eden Girls' College secured First Division in the B.Sc. (Pass) examination while the Central Women's College had the best pass percentage at 91.6.

None passed the B.A. (Pass) examination from Sheikh Lutfar Rahman College, Kotalipara. So was the case with Ibrahim Khan College in the B.Sc. (Pass) examination.

In the B.Com. (Pass) examination no student from 27 colleges were successful. They are: Amtali Degree College, Amtali;

B. College, Bikrampur; Sonargaon Degree College, Sonargon; Terosree Degree College, Tersree; Ispahani College, Dhaka; Salimullah College, Dhaka; Bangabasi College, and a private candidate at Mymensingh.

In the BA (Pass) examination 9,885 students out of 42,264 passed. The percentage of pass was 23.39. Six secured First Division 3,437 second and 6,442 Third Division.

In the B.Sc. (Pass) 2,038 examinees passed out of 7,405 candidates sitting for the examination. The percentage of pass 27.5. Twenty-eight secured First Division, 981 second and 1,029 Third Division.

In the B.Com. (Pass) examination 2,497 students passed out of a total of 9,965. The percentage of pass being 25.06. None secured First Division while 521 passed in Second Division and 1,976 in the Third Division.
