Expelled students gherao college Principal

BOGRA, May 15:—The Principal of a local college was gheraoed in his office today by degree examinees, many of them expelled during last two days, reports UNB.

The examinees were reportedly demonstrating against expulsion of fellow candidates for adopting unfair means and demanding the right to copy freely.

They also allegedly misbehaved with several teachers of Shah Sultan College during the demonstration.

Police on duty, however, managed to disperse the demonstrators and arrested two of them from the spot. One of the arrested was identified as Aurangajeb, said, to be a non-examinee.

Protesting the incident, Principal Lutfar Rahman informed the Deputy Commissioner of his inability to continue discharging his duties of holding the degree examination at his college, sources close to the Principal said.

A large number of candidates including VP, GS and AGS of the college union were expelled on Monday for adopting unfair means in the examination, it was learnt.

Meanwhile, seven candidates were expelled from four centres of the district today for adopting unfair means.

According to another report 34 examinees were expelled from three centres in Nawabganj district today. Of them, 24 were from the Nawabganj Government College centre.

Police today arrested six expelled examinees in connection with an incident in the Government College centre on Monday. Several expelled examinees along with outsiders stormed the centre and caused damage to college property protesting their expulsion.
