Provosts of Dhaka University on Thursday expressed satisfaction at the attendance of examinees in the ongoing examinations, reports BSS.

But they opined that the desired atmosphere could not be regained in the halls until the entrance of the armed hoodlums was stopped.

They said this in a meeting of Provosts Committee held with the Vice-Chancellor Prof M. Moniruzzaman Miah in the chair.
