

CU exams postponed

CHITTAGONG, Jan. 6:—The M.A., M.Sc., M.Com. final examinations (1988) and the second-year B.A. Honours examination (1990) under the University of Chittagong scheduled to begin on January 14 and 17 respectively, have been postponed due to unavoidable circumstances, a University Press release said.

Fresh dates for the examinations will be announced later.

examinations scheduled to commence on January 12.

A meeting of the Deans of different faculties and representatives of colleges held today with the Vice-Chancellor Prof. Alamgir M. Serajuddin presiding discussed various matters relating to the examination.

The meeting warned that the examination centres found involved in irregularities, including violation of the university rules and regulations, would not be acceptable to the authority and appropriate actions would be taken against them.

A total of 42,897 candidates from 104 colleges and the externals are appearing at the examinations.

Chittagong University authority last year cancelled two examination centres and took punitive actions against 2214 examinees for committing irregularities in examinations.
