DU exams suspended

The Dhaka University Authorities Wednesday suspended all the examinations under the course system scheduled to be held between July 18 and August 3, university sources said in Dhaka on Wednesday, reports BSS.

Fresh dates will be announced in due time. However, the final part examination of Economics (M.S.S. 2nd batch) will be held as per schedule on July 18, the sources said.

Earlier about 200 examinees of honours and master's degree classes staged a demonstration in front of the Vice-Chancellor's office and handed over him a memorandum demanding shifting of the examination dates due to the July 31 DUCSU and hall union polls. They withdrew their demonstration following the assurances given by the Vice-Chancellor that the issue would be discussed with the Controller of the Examinations and the concerned officials.

In the memorandum the examinees said that it was not possible to prepare their studies just before the DUCSU and hall union elections as the electioneering was getting momentum.
