452 candidates expelled HSC exam begins

The Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examinations of 1992 under four education Boards began on Thursday reports BSS.

According to reports from the boards, the first day examinations (Bangla-first paper) passed off peacefully. The number of candidates appearing in the examinations under the boards is two lakh 47 thousand and 669.

A total of 452 candidates were expelled from different centres of the country for adopting unfair means in the examination, board officials told BSS over telephone on Thursday.

According to reports, 133 candidates were expelled from

various centres of Dhaka Board, 137 from Rajshahi Board, 175 from Comilla Board and seven from Jessore Board.

Education Minister Jamiruddin Sircar on Thursday visited the HSC examination centres at Dhaka Residential Model College, Mohammadpur Central College, Dhaka College and Eden Girls' College in the city.

The Education Minister talked to the investigators about the conditions prevailing in these centres. Chairman of Dhaka Education Board and Deputy Commissioner of Dhaka accompanied the minister during the visit.
