SSC students damage 6 vehicles in city

The Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examinees brought out isolated processions in the city on Tuesday in support of their three-point demand and damaged six motor vehicles.

According to reports, three motor cars were damaged by processionists at Wari in the morning while two minibuses at Mirpur and one baby taxi at Maghbazar.

Police sources said that several isolated processions were brought out at Mirpur area but prevented to march towards Press Club by Police. Later, the processionists pelted stones on the running minibuses. A baby taxi suddenly came under attack of students at Moghbazar in the noon.

Meanwhile, most of the previously picked up examinees with Motijheel Police, Mirpur Police and Sutrapur Police have been released on bond signed by their respective guardians.
