

429 examinees expelled on 4th day in 3 dists

KUSHTIA, June 23: Some 85 HSC examinees were expelled from different centres of the district on charge of adopting unfair means in English 2nd paper examination held on Tuesday, reports UNB.

Of them 24 were expelled from Bheramara, 18 from Mirpur, 12 from Amla, 10 from Islamia College, 9 from Daulatpur, 5 from Khoksa, 4 from Kushtia government College,

one each from Kushtia Government Women College, Kumarkhali and Mothurapur College.

In English first paper, 70 examinees were also expelled from various centres in the district. Of them 22 were from Amla, 14 from Islamia College, 10 from Bheramara, 8 from Mirpur, 5 from Daulatpur, 4 each in Mothurapur and Kumarkhali, 2 from Government College and one from Khoksha College.

Another report inform: A total of 26 HSC examinees were expelled from 10 centres of the district on Tuesday, the 4th day of examination, for adopting unfair means.

Of the expelled, six were from Day-Night College Centre, one each from BL College, Suhrawardy College, three from Mohsin College and two each from Shundarban College and Bangabandhu College, official sources said.

There are 18 examination centres in the district, officials said.

BSS inform from Chittagong: Three hundred and eighteen candidates from 49 centres of the district were expelled Tuesday for adopting unfair means in the examination hall on the fourth day of higher secondary certificate examination.

According to district control room of the expelled candidates 50 are from Rangonia 78 from Anwara, 26 from Uttar Rangonia, 23 from Muslim Education Society College and 15 from Raojan.
