

800 expelled on 2nd day of SSC exam

Some 800 candidates and 11 invigilators were expelled on the second day of SSC Examination under the four education boards for adopting unfair means, officials said, reports UNB.

On the first day of the examination on Monday, about 700 examinees and five invigilators were expelled from different centres throughout the country.

The Secondary School Certificate Examination of 1993 of Dhaka, Rajshahi, Comilla and Jessore boards of the country began Monday morning under strict measures to prevent unfair means. Examination of Bengali 2nd paper was held on Tuesday.

A total of 679,010 candidates were appearing at the examination this year from 611 centres across the country. Of them, 88 examinees are sitting for the exam at 5 centres abroad under the Dhaka Board. Among the candidates, 434,895 are male and 244,115 female.

According to reports reaching in Dhaka 95 examinees were expelled in Dhaka Board. An invigilator was also expelled from the Pangsha, Rajbari centres for allegedly assisting examination fraud. There are 154 centres in Dhaka Board.

Some 314 examinees were expelled

led from Rajshahi Board centres. Eight invigilators were also expelled from the Sadullahpur centre of Gaibandha district, for allegedly assisting the candidates in copying answers.

The number of examination centres in Rajshahi Board is 158. On the first day, over 300 examinees were expelled in the board.

In Comilla Board, a senior official said, some 369 students were expelled on Tuesday. A total of 179 centres have been set up in this board. On the first day, over 200 were expelled in this Board.

About 13 examinees were expelled from 30 centres of the Jessore Board, according to reports available with the Controller of Examinations.

The number of examinees in Dhaka Board is 219,582—135,024 male and 84,558 female. In Rajshahi Board a total of 154,318 students were sitting for the exam, including 102,044 male and 52,274 female.

A total of 167,416 candidates—107,461 male and 59,955 female—are appearing at the SSC Exam from Comilla Board. The number of candidates in Jessore Board is 137,694—90,366 male and 47,328 female.

Eighty-eight candidates are appearing from five centres in Jeddah, Riyadh, Abu Dhabi, Doha and Tripoli under the purview of Dhaka Board.

Meanwhile, Dhaka Metropolitan Police has banned movement and assembly of more than four people within 200 yards of 90 examination centres in the city from Monday till May 13.

The restriction will remain in force during the examination hours.

2 expelled from Nilphamari centres

Our Nilphamari correspondent says:—Two SSC examinees were expelled from two centres of Nilphamari district today in the first paper of Bangla each from Dimla and Jaldhaka centre.

49 examinees fail to appear in exam

Bagerhat correspondent adds:—Some 49 SSC examinees of Morelgonj Town High School under Morelgonj Thana in the district of Bagerhat could not appear in the SSC examination that commenced on April 19 for nonavailability of their admit cards.

It is learnt from a reliable source that the teachers and the managing committee of the schools allowed those students (who are irregular) to fill up the examination forms against a huge amount illegally and sent the same to the Jessore Education Board but the board did not issue any admit cards for them.
