HSC exam begins tomorrow

The Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examination, 1993 under four education boards of the country begins on Thursday, reports BSS.

A total of three lakh 39 thousand 524 candidates are appearing in the examination from 665 centres including 10 abroad.

There will be 105 sub-centres throughout the country, said an official Press release.

The Government has taken all measures to hold the examination in a peaceful atmosphere, it said. It has appointed vigilance teams to pay surprise visits to the examination centres, the Press release said.

Besides, the education boards and district administrations will form vigilance teams with a view to holding the examination in peaceful and fair manner, it said.

The Public Examination Offence Act, 1980 will be strictly enforced during the examination, it said.

The law-enforcing agencies have been instructed to maintain law and order in and around the examination centres, it said.
