

JCD, BCL men clash on DU campus

At least ten students were injured in a clash between Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) and Bangladesh Chhatra League (S-P) activists on Tuesday at Dhaka University campus.

The incident took place at about 11-30 am when a procession of about 30 supporters of JCD, brought out under the banner of Dhaka University Inquilab Readers Forum, was allegedly attacked by BCL activists in front of Madhus canteen.

At least five hand bombs were also blasted allegedly by the rival groups.

At one stage some BCL

activists damaged the microphone of JCD near "Aperajay Bangla".

The agitated JCD activists, on the other hand ransacked three private cars of the University teachers near the Arts Faculty. The JCD activists also ransacked some furniture of Madhu's canteen.

The BCL leaders at a rally held in front of Arts Faculty said that JCD in the name Inquilab Readers Forum tried to establish the anti-liberation forces on DU campus.

The rally was addressed by BCL General Secretary Ishak Ali Khan Panna, Shahajan Alam Saju, Mahbubul Hoq, Shakil, Iqbal Hossain Apu, Rafiqul Islam, Sujit Roy Nondy and Pankaj Nath.

The leaders of Inquilab readers forum at a rally held under the foot of Aperajay Bangla protested the incident.

President of Dhaka University Teachers Association (DUTA) Prof Mostafa Chowdhury and its General Secretary Prof Hossain Monsur in a statement on Tuesday, strongly protested the ransacking of three DU teacher's private cars by a group of JCD activists.

The DUTA leaders demanded punitive action against the accused.
