

## DU student arrested from F Rahman Hall

A student of Dhaka University was arrested by plainclothes men from the Sir A F Rahman Hall in the early hours of yesterday on charge of staying at the hall illegally.

According to sources, Idris Mohammad Asif, a resident student of the Hazi Mohammad Mohsin Hall, was driven out by his rivals some days ago. Then he took shelter at the Zahurul Haq Hall. But after being driven out from there, he started staying at Room No 520 of the AF Rahman Hall. He came to the hall at around 10:30 pm on Sunday.

Talking to The Daily Star last night, Provost Prof Harun-or-Rashid said that he informed the police about the student. A couple of weeks ago, the hall authorities put up a notice regarding illegal staying at the hall.

"The hall is now almost free from the outsiders. If we find anybody staying at the hall illegally, we will take action immediately," he said.

A case has been lodged with Ramna Thana under Section 54 and the arrested was produced before the court yesterday.

Meanwhile, the university authority has announced that no outsiders will be allowed to stay at any of the university dormitories and law enforcing agency personnel could arrest them without permission of the authority.
