Outsiders driven out of Sheikh Mujib Hall

The general students of the Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Hall of the Dhaka University on Friday set an example by driving out the outsiders from the hall following a police raid in the hall at around 10 pm.

During the raid, police arrested four outsiders including one who is not even a student of the University. The arrested are identified as terrorists who belong to the Gopalganj Faction of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL). They are: Pankaj, Lipton, Mintu and Kiron.

Immediately after the police raid, the agitated general students came out of their rooms with sticks and drove away the remaining outsiders forcefully. The students were enraged when earlier in the afternoon he identified terrorists beat the Manager of the Hall Canteen and demanded Taka 5000 from him.

The General Secretary of the Dhaka University (BCL) Unit and a residential student of the Hall AKM Azim lent support to the general students' move against the outsiders during the incident late at night.

The hall is at present totally free from the outsiders. Identity cards are being checked at the entrance of the hall and the hall gate is closed at 11 pm now.
