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New office timings during Ramzan

The Government on Wednesday announced new time schedules to be followed in various offices in and outside Dhaka during the holy month of Ramzan. reports BSS.

According to an official handout, Ministries, the Secretariat, Departments and offices attached to the Secretariat, Directorates and other attached offices, autonomous organisations and corporations in Dhaka will hold office from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. without break.

Divisional, district, upazila offices, mofussil courts and other offices in and outside the capital will sit from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. without break. But permission will be given for offering Jehr prayers.

This time-schedule is applicable to government offices, organisations and corporations. But Banks, Posts, Telegraph and Telephone, Railway, hospitals, nationalised industrial units, mills and factories and other offices of essential services will follow their own time schedules in accordance with their own rules considering the public interest.

After the ramzan month the present time schedule will be followed again, the handout said.
