Indian scientists' team calls on Eunos

A four-member delegation of Indian Council for Scientific and Industrial Research called on State Minister for Education Principal Mohammad Eunos Khan at the latter's office in Dhaka on Monday, says BSS.

The members of the delegation apprised the State Minister of the progress made in India in the field of scientific and industrial research and showed keen interest in promoting bilateral cooperation between Bangladesh and India in this field.

The State Minister exchanged ideas with the Indian scientists and laid emphasis on increased cooperation of SAARC countries for scientific and technological development in the days ahead. He pointed out that the present democratic government had given due importance to this sector for achieving development.
