

BCS exam results

Bangladesh Public Service Commission has selected 1,886 candidates for provisional appointment in various cadres of BCS (General Education) on the basis of results of the 14th BCS (special) Examination 1992, reports UNB.

The final selection will be made after medical examination and police verification, said a Press release of

the Public Service Commission on Saturday.

Letters will be issued to each of the recruits later to face medical board to be formed by the Directorate of Health.

Among the candidates, 125 were selected as Lecturer in Bengali, 159 in English, 153 in Economics, 151 in Political Science, 120 in General History, 97 in Islamic History, 123 in Philosophy, 119 each in Accounting and Management, 100 in Mathematics, 102 in Physics, 85 in Chemistry, 110 in Botany, 105 in Zoology, 27 in Geography, 45 Social Welfare, 10 Statistics, 14 Psychology, 11 Home Economics, 3 Soil Science, 14 in Arabic, 34 in Islamic Studies, 31 in Sociology, 3 in Sanskrit and 2 in Agriculture Science.

The rest 24 were selected in various disciplines for different Teacher Training Colleges.
