

Varsity officers begin ten-day strike today

Bangladesh Inter University Officers Federation embarks on a 10-day strike from today (Saturday) to press for modification of their downgraded pay scale, reports UNB.

Leaders of the federation announced this at a press conference at Dhaka University TSC Seminar Room on Friday.

They also demand inclusion of their representatives in the senate, syndicate, finance committee and academic councils of all universities of the country.

The federation leaders regretted that despite repeated assurances the authorities had done nothing to realise their two-point demand.

Md Ziaul Haque, President of the federation, read out a written statement at the press conference.

The leaders threatened to go for a greater action programme if the authorities fail to meet their demands.
