

All-party JS body on campus violence formed

A 15-member, all-party parliamentary committee was constituted by the Jatiya Sangsad Tuesday to chalk out measures and adopt appropriate steps to free the country's educational institutions from the prevalent violence, reports BSS.

The committee was proposed by Dr Badruddoza Chowdhury, Deputy Leader of the House and approved by the Sangsad unanimously.

The decision to form the committee was taken by the Jatiya Sangsad after elaborate discussions on the campus violence on August 14. It has eight members from the Treasury Bench and seven from the Opposition Benches.

The committee is headed by Law and Justice Minister Mirza Gholam Hafiz. The members are: Prof Badodurroza Chodhury, Ma-
