

APSU calls strike at CU from today

CHITTAGONG, Nov 22 (UNB): All Party Student Unity (APSU) called for an indefinite strike from tomorrow (Saturday) at the Chittagong University protesting the alleged attack by Islami Chhatra Shibir on the VC's residence recently.

But the strike call evoked a sense of uncertainty among the candidates of honours final year examination scheduled to begin November 24 (Sunday) as per fresh programme announced by the authorities.

The examination was earlier scheduled to begin Thursday (Nov 21) but by postponed Wednesday midnight due to a two-day strike enforced by the APSU, also protesting the Shibir attack Monday on VC's residence.

The Shibir activists have been agitating for a long time.
