## BCL call to stop repression on opposition

Bangladesh Chhatra League (A-A) at a rally on Wednesday urged the government to stop repression on the opposition leaders and activists.

Otherwise, it warned to build movement along with the people against the government's what it called, undemocratic activities.

BCL held the rally in front of the National Press Club after the release of its leaders who were arrested from Bangabandhu Avenue on Tuesday. The leaders are Tofael, Tabul Chowdhury and Sazzad Ripon.

The speakers at the rally alleged that the government was trying to stop the students movement through repression.

They said that the ruling party's student front had created a reign of terror in the educational arena to establish its supremacy. The JCD

armed elements had killed several student leaders and activists of different student organisations in order to dominate student politics in the country, they further alleged. They said the killers of BCL leaders Mizanur Rahman were moving frequently. Without arresting them the government was arresting BCL leaders and activists through filing false cases.

They demanded arrest and trial of those responsible for the killing of three BCL leaders in Chittagong.

They also urged the student organisations to build movement aimed at putting pressure on the government to implement the 10-point demands of students community.

The rally was addressed by Ahmed Hossain, Golam Mostafa Suzan and Kamruzzaman Ansari.
