

Close halls to flush out terrorists

CHITTAGONG, Dec 11 (BSS): Speakers at a public meeting here today expressed grave concern over continued terrorism in the Chittagong University campus by the Jamaat-Shibir clique and the government silence over the matter.

They said that academic atmosphere was absent in the campus and thus the future of a large number of students had become uncertain.

The meeting held under the auspices of Chittagong University Terrorism Resistance Committee of the Citizens was presided over by the committee convener Prof. Muhammad Khaled. It was addressed, among others by Advocate Ibrahim Hussain Babul, General Secretary of Chittagong Ainjibi Samity, City Awami League General Secretary ADM Mahiuddin, JSD leader Advocate Abul Kalam.
