

Edward College closed following students clash

PABNA, July 7:—Pabna Government Edward College was declared closed today for one week and its annual examinations were suspended for an indefinite period following post-election clashes between pro-BNP JCD and pro-AL BCL armed activists for the last two consecutive days after the college reopened on Saturday.

University examinations will however continue as per schedule, according to the college authorities.

They college remained closed till Friday beginning from Monday last after holding of Edward College Students Union election peacefully on Sunday last.

BCL won the elections in all the 22 seats.

About 8 to ten cases and counter cases have been instituted by both sides before Pabna Police in connection with the incident.

Four Chhatra League leaders including outgoing VP and GS have been arrested in connection with the cases.

Installation ceremony of the newly elected cabinet is yet to be held.
