Four students of Tejgaon College injured in attack

Four students of Tejgaon College were injured when a group of armed outsiders attacked some students at the college compound at 11 am on Saturday.

Police said Dipu (22) and Aslam (20) were admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital with bullet wounds. Aslam was transferred to Mohakhali Chest Hospital and Dipu was released in the afternoon.

Two others—Badal and Tanveer—were given first aid at a private clinic at Farmgate.

some armed outsiders climbed on the boundary wall of the college and opened fire on the students without any provocation.

Students belonging to Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal were busy in a meeting at the college canteen to form a convening committee of the college unit of Chhatra Dal.

The outsiders continued attack with firearms and hand bombs for about 20 minutes and were chased by the students.

Students then brought out a protest procession and came out of the campus.

ANOTHER CLASH

Meanwhile, another procession organized by Jatiya Party supporters reached near the police box at Farmgate and confronted with the students procession.

There was a fresh clash between the students and Jatiya Party supporters. Fresh gunshots were heard during the clash. Police, deployed near the overbridge, however, remained silent till the rival groups dispersed.
