709 lecturers promoted

Meanwhile, the government yesterday (Saturday) approved promotion of 709 lecturers of the government colleges to the post of assistant professors.

These promotion cases were under pending for a long time, an official handout said.

The government is also taking appropriate measures to promote about 400 more lecturers as early as possible.

Actions are also being initiated to fill up the vacant positions of associate professors and professors in the government colleges through promotions.

Recruitments to fill up the resultant vacancies in the posts of lecturer will be made as early as possible, the handout said.
