Gun battle on DU campus continues

At least 20 rounds of gunshots were exchanged between the supporters of two rival student organisations on the second consecutive day on Thursday.

Earlier, they exchanged at least 70 rounds of gunshots when Zahan, a Bangladesh Chhatra League (A-A) activist received bullet injury on Wednesday.

On Thursday, the clash ensued when a procession of Bangladesh Chhatra League (A-A) has passing by a rally of Bangladesh Jatyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) held at Aparajeo Bangla. The activists of both organisations used fire arms during the clash. None was however hurt in the firing.

Later, the rally of JCD held at Aparajeo Bangla which was addressed, among others, by Jatyatabad

The JCD leader claimed that the BCL armed hoodlums are responsible for the violence. They demanded punishment to those responsible for the violence and called upon the student community to build resistance against terrorism.

At one stage, the BCL activists damaged at least five vehicles at Plassy crossing.
