Gunshots heard, DU campus tense again

Dhaka University campus Monday again became tense following an exercise of arms by a group of activists of a rival students organisations near TSC in the evening.

Panic gripped the campus following a series of bomb explosion and gun-shots.

Meanwhile, a peace effort was made by the leaders of two rival student organisations Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) and Chhatra League (A-A) for their rehabilitation in the different dormitories of the university from where they had been ousted earlier.

The violent incident of the evening, however, diminished prospects of the peace move, said a student leader.

JCD RALLY

BSS adds: Bangladesh Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) Mon-

day evening brought out a procession on Dhaka University campus demanding arrest and trial of the killers of Dr Shamsul Alam Khan Milon and Mahbubur Rahman.

The processionists raised slogans against suspected killers of Milon and Mahbub and also against the Awami League chief for allegedly giving shelter to the killers in her student front, Bangladesh Chhatra League (S-A).

SPORADIC GUNSHOTS

UNB adds: Sporadic gunshots were heard from different hall areas in the Dhaka University campus on Monday night.

Campus sources said 15 to 20 rounds of blank fire were heard between 10 and 10.30 pm, spreading panic among the residential student.
