Student rallies in city

Students were restive in the city yesterday also. Incidents of student demonstrations and police action marked the day.

Police fired at least 14 tear gas canisters upon unruly activists of the Awami League backed Chhatra League (A-A) yesterday afternoon in front of Dhaka College. No one was however, injured.

Police sources said that they had to resort to teargassing when some activists of Chhatra League (A-A) chased two students of Titumir College who were activists of pro-BNP Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal.

Meanwhile Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) brought out a procession and held a rally yesterday in front of Modu's Canteen at the Dhaka University campus protesting rampaging of vehicles and terrorism of Chhatra League (A-A) in the city Tuesday.

Speakers slated BCL (A-A) for unleashing terrorism in the city in the name of movement. They called upon all to resist the terrorists.

The rally was addressed among others by DUCSU Assistant General Secretary Nazimuddin Alam, Habibunnabi Sohel, President of JCD of DU Unit, Rafiqul Islam Jaglu and Saifuddin Dulal.

Democratic Student Alliance (DSA), a group of left leaning student groups, held another rally at the Modhu's Canteen to protest against police action on the Chhatra League (A-A).

The gathering was addressed by Rokunuzzaman Rokon, President of JSD (Inu) backed Chhatra League (N-S) of DU unit and Mostaque Alam Tulu, President of pro-BSD Samajtantric Chhatra Front, DU Unit.

Earlier, DSA brought out a procession on the campus.

In another development, the Central Law College was closed.
