Teacher problems in Shariatpur govt girls school

SHARIATPUR, April 2: Shariatpur Govt. Girls' High School is facing shortage of headmistress, assistant teachers and other employees for long.

The posts of Headmistress and Assistant Teachers of Shariatpur Govt. Girls' High School located in Shariatpur Zila Sadar sell vacant for a long time. An Assistant Teacher, allegedly not qualified, is now in charge of headmistress. She cannot run the school properly due to lack of knowledge of administrative rules. The students' education will be hampered immensely if she is allowed to run the school.

The school requires a qualified Headmaster or Headmistress urgently to conduct educational course fairly and smoothly for the betterment of the students of this school.

OTHER PROBLEMS

There are five teachers instead of 18 to conduct the educational course. Only 5 teachers cannot afford to carry out the task of 18 teachers. It may be mentioned that due to want of a teacher to teach mathematics and science, the students of science group are the worst sufferers. Their future is uncertain due to teacher crisis. There is a gate-keeper who is never to be seen in carrying out his duty. As the gate-keeper is affectionate to the Acting Headmistress he has been enjoying various amenities who is mostly seen moving outside during the school hours. The Headmistress appears to have approved it. Sometimes the gatekeeper allegedly behaves roughly with the teachers and other employees. When informed the Headmistress takes no legal action or effective measure against the gatekeeper Ali Almad.

The students of the school brought out a procession and submitted a memorandum containing five-point demands to the Deputy Commissioner, Shariatpur for redress of the grievances.
